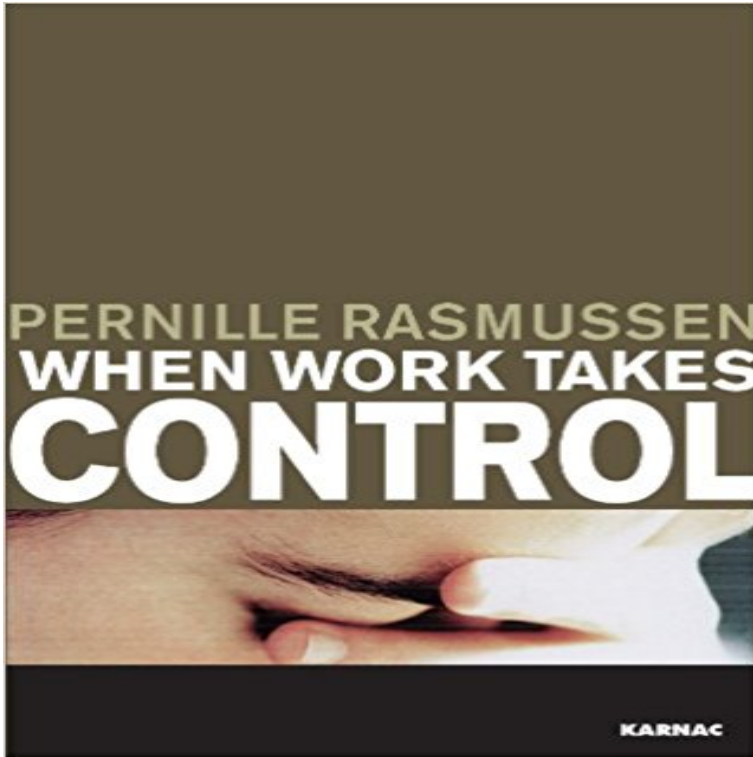


When Work Takes Control: The Psychology and Effects of Work Addiction
